## Travel from Edinburgh to Bordeaux after the meeting

There are a number of options for travel from Edinburgh Airport (EDI) to Bordeaux Airport (BOD). We have listed the most common routes from searches, but you should confirm plans with your travel provider.

If you wish to travel to London or Southampton as an intermediate point on Friday 4th July, there are a number of options. Travel to Edinburgh Airport is easiest by taxi, which can be arranged by contacting the conference organisers.

If you prefer, you can travel by train from **Leuchars** to **Edinburgh Haymarket**, then catch an express coach to the airport – please note there are **no** direct train services to Edinburgh Airport.
